

Tourist Attractions...

**Here are some dog friendly
tourist attractions locally:**

WELSH HIGHLAND RAILWAY

Dogs are charged at £2.50 but are not allowed in the first class carriages. Leaflet available in reception with time table.

HISTORIC MONUMENTS / CASTLES

Dogs are welcome at the following CADW sites: Criccieth Castle, Dolbadarn Castle in Llanberis, Holyhead Mountain Hut Circles, Segontium Roman Fort in Caernarfon.

SNOWDON

Dogs are not allowed on the Mountain Railway but you can walk up. A lead is advisable due to sheep and lots of people. Take some water with you and stick to an easy route.

PENRHYN CASTLE

Dogs are allowed in the castle grounds (National Trust).

GLYNLLIFON PARK

Historic gardens and country park. Dogs are allowed if kept on a lead.

Hello! I am happy to welcome a fellow well behaved pooch to Plas Dinas.

The humans do have a few "doggie rules" that we have to follow!

- I have to stay off the furniture and so do you
- My owners watch me like a hawk and clean up after me with the bags provided (more on request), bins are at the end of the car park
- We are not allowed in the Dining Room at any time
- Your owners should only leave you on your own in the bedroom during mealtimes
- If you are noisy when left alone, you'll have to move to the car
- You can be fed outside or in the bathroom on the tiled floor
- Your paws should be wiped with the doggie towel provided on returning inside from wet or dirty conditions

Beach Information...

Here's some information on local beaches to help you when deciding where to take your dog.

Between 1st May & 30th September, the following beaches have dog exclusion areas:

Abersoch, Aberdaron, Aberdyfi, Abermaw, Barmouth, Criccieth, Dinas Dinlle, Fairbourne, Harlech, Llandanwg, Morfa Bychan (Black Rock Sands), Pwllheli, Porth Tywyn, Porthoer (Whistling Sands—total dog ban), Tywyn near Aberdyfi.

Dogs are allowed on the beach either side of the restriction areas, which are clearly sign posted.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times on the promenade and owners are required to clean up any mess after their dog.

Dog fouling bags are available from the Council's Beach Supervisors, which are on duty on most of the above beaches between the middle of June and the first week in September.

Our closest beach is Dinas Dinlle which is really nice.

Turn right out of the drive, follow the road to Pwllheli for about 2 miles and turn right at the sign for Caernarfon Airport. Follow the road and you come out at the beach. Drive to the furthest car park for the quietest area.

Hole in the Wall Street, Caernarfon, LL55 1RF.

Friendly pub with a good selection of beers.
