THE HOUSE

HISTORY

Mid-seventeenth century but with extensive Victorian additions. Came into the possession of the Armstrong-Jones family in the 19th century. 1899 Sir Robert Jones, who altered his name to Armstrong-Jones, had a son named Ronald. His marriage produced a son, Antony, who in 1961 married HRH Princess Margaret. Lord Snowdon became a famous photographer & organised the Investiture ceremony for Prince Charles at Caernarfon Castle.

Margaret regularly spent weekends at Plas Dinas during this period in their marriage. 1980s, the house, became a grand nursing home, then a hotel in the early 1990s. It still retains many family portraits, memorabilia and original furniture.

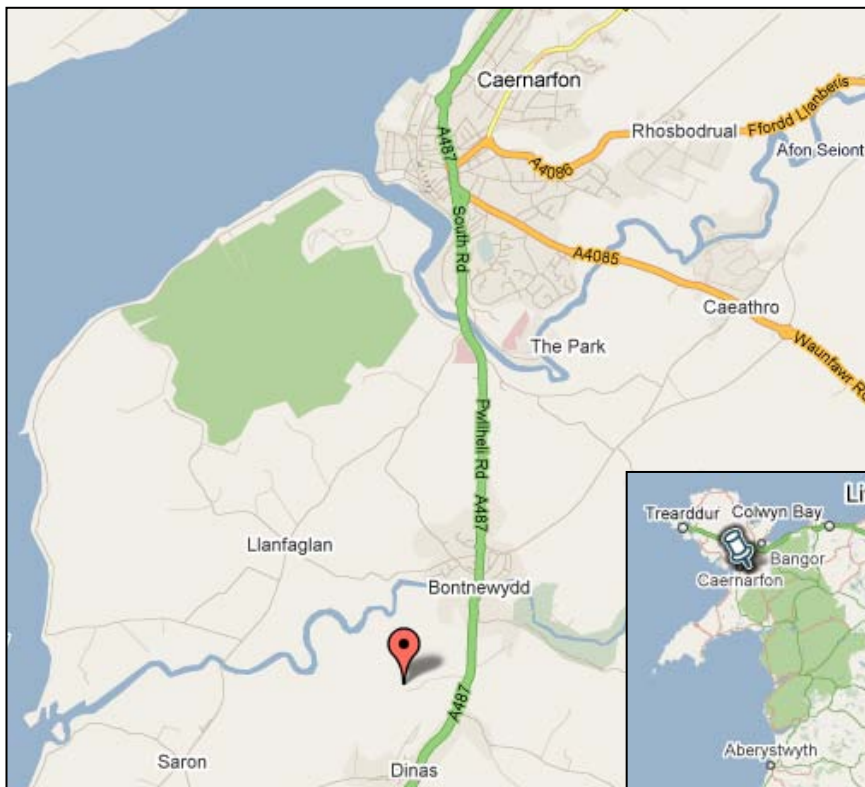

DIRECTIONS

Travelling south along the A487 from Caernarfon towards Porthmadog you go through the village of Bontnewydd. You will pass the Newborough Arms pub on your left. We are a third of a mile past the pub, on the brow of the hill on your right hand side. We are clearly signposted from either direction. As you enter the driveway you will pass the Lodge on the left and continue down the tree lined drive for around half a mile until you reach the house.
